# Medical Surveillance for Columbia University Personnel who work in Autopsy, Gross or Anatomical Pathology, DermatoPathology, or Anatomical Gift Morgue

### Personnel Covered

Personnel who work in Autopsy, Gross or Anatomical Pathology, DermatoPathology, or Anatomical Gift Morgue with large amounts of formalin ( $\leq 0.5$  L) will receive a preplacement and periodic examination.

Personnel in the DermatoPathology and/or Pathology Department with any of the following job titles:

- o Chief Tech
- o Senior Tech
- Tech Assistant
- Lab Assistant
- Pathology Assistant
- Clerk (in accession area)

- Staff Associate
- Officer of Instruction (OOI) or Officer of Research (OOR) who does not have an NYP Appointment
- Any instructor who will be grossing large specimens, including Anatomy Department.

## **Identification of Covered Personnel:**

1. Careers at Columbia (Talentlink) – Human Resources or RAPs – Office of Faculty Affairs

#### Protocol:

- 1. Health Questionnaire
- 2. Occupational History
- 3. Physical Examination including vital signs
- 4. Quantiferon tuberculosis test.
- 5. Offer a tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) vaccine every 10 years.

6. Exposure Occ Risk 1<sup>a</sup>, provide blood borne pathogen exposure surveillance including HCV antibody, and offer HBV vaccine series<sup>b</sup>.

- 8. Personnel required to wear a respirator for their work need medical clearance<sup>c</sup>.
- 9. Spirometry, if needed -refer to Spirometry Criteria document.

10. In accordance with Occ Risk 1<sup>a</sup> exposure group requirements, vision acuity and color screen where vision acuity and color is important to the Eee function in that role.

Workforce Health & Safety (WH&S) shall notify the individual of the results of the examination.

- 1. Utilize Workforce Health & Safety (WH&S) forms
- 2. Clearance Human Resources (HR) or Office of Faculty Affairs (OFA)
- 3. Questionable cases referred to Environmental Health & Safety (EH&S)
